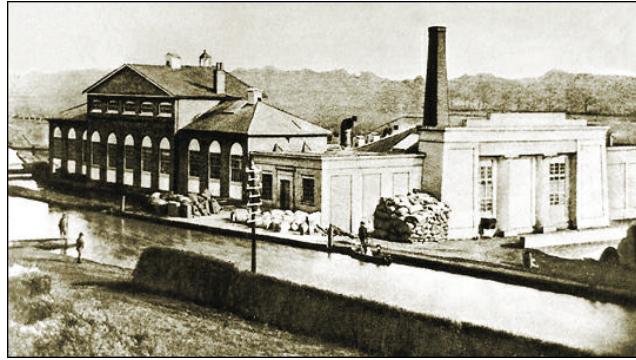

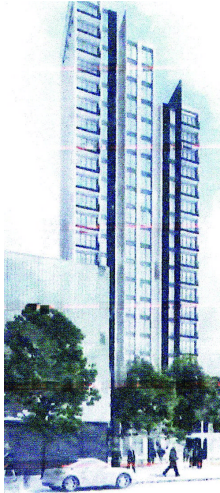
**Ralph - Evensyde**

NEWS ON ASCOT ROAD DEVELOPMENT



This proposed development has been constantly in the local newspapers and Croxley News magazine. Local people are quite rightly up in arms about the plans for this monster of a building/s. Originally it was thought that houses would be built on this land in keeping with what you can see locally. Admittedly there are a few higher buildings but we are talking 5 or 6 storeys not 23 or 25. We realise that maybe some flats must be built because of the lack of land. Watford Borough have not looked at past mistakes by councils, most of them have pulled down their old high rise buildings. You can still look on the Watford Borough Council website – the planning application number is 17/00048/FULM (simply search <http://pa.watford.gov.uk/publicaccess/>) then type in the planning number. The Croxley Green Residents Association are still trying to block this proposal. 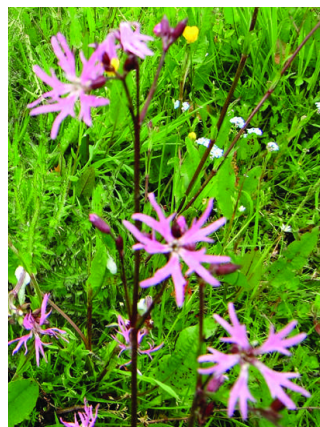

FOULING – FIX MY STREET ARE HERE TO HELP

FixMyStreet covers the whole of the UK <https://www.fixmystreet.com> is an independent website, built by the charity mySociety. You can report problems in your community, even if you don't know who those reports should go to. FixMyStreet sends your reports direct to your local council. They are then published online so others in the community can read, discuss and offer advice where/when needed. All you have to do is type in a postcode and describe your problem for example **Dog Fouling**. Then they send your report to the people whose job it is to fix it. There is an app for iOS and an Android app, Nokia Ovi app. If your phone isn't supported try accessing FixMyStreet via your mobile browser. FixMyStreet is primarily for reporting things which are broken or dirty or damaged or dumped, and need fixing, cleaning or clearing, like graffiti, **dog fouling**, potholes or street lights that don't work. Hopefully this can help in the fight to stop children getting Toxocariasis from dog faeces. Biodegradable bags are **FREE** from the Parish Council Offices and some libraries. Always think of others and use bags to pick up after your pet and then **BIN IT!**



Fraudsters are turning to "kindness" with new scam emails claiming they have accidentally received your details. The "phishing" email is sent to you by a fraudster who describes themselves a "law-abiding citizen" and who says that someone has mistakenly sent them a file with personal information about you. Attached is a document which they claim contains your personal details. The fraudster suggests that your details may be available to scammers and that to see what may have been shared, you need to open the attachment. **DO NOT OPEN THE ATTACHED DOCUMENT** the attachment opens the door to malware being downloaded onto your computer. The malware attempts to obtain sensitive data, such as your banking credentials and passwords; this is then used to try to steal your money. In order to protect yourself from malware, having up-to-date virus protection is essential; but it will not always prevent you from becoming infected. **Protect yourself:** - • Don't click on links or attachments you receive in unsolicited emails or SMS messages. Remember fraudsters can 'spoo' an email address to look like one used by someone you trust. If unsure, check the email header to identify the true source. • Do not enable macros in downloads, enabling the macro will allow the malware to be installed onto your device. • Always install software updates as soon as they are available. • Create regular backups of your important files to an external hard drive, memory stick or online storage provider. Don't leave the backup device connected to your computer. • If you think your bank details have been compromised, contact your bank immediately.

**Don't be the cause of an accident. 20mph or less !!**

**PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY** around the estate and park sensibly so that visibility is not obscured for either pedestrians or other vehicles. Please, please can you keep your

speeds down – **20mph or less** is best. Please think of others and try not to park on pavements or on blind spots. (Parking large vehicles on or close to corners is not advisable.) If your vehicle damages a pavement you will have to be charged for the repair. Please always think of others when driving and parking around Byewaters.

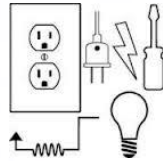

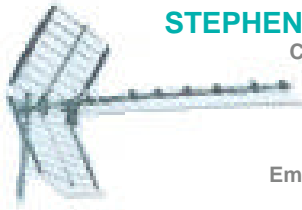

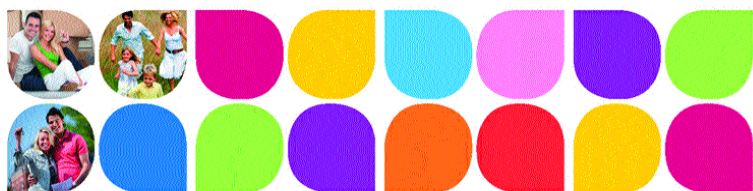
