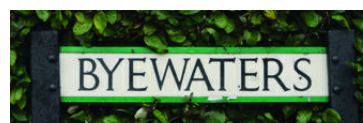

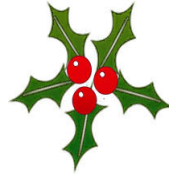

Feeding swans and ducks bread, once a beloved tradition for many families, this has in recent years become a guilty pleasure as campaigners warn it is not a healthy food for the birds. Now, the Queen's Swan Guard has warned that the campaign to 'bin the bread' has caused swans to starve as people have stopped feeding them, it has done more harm than good. The Queen's Swan Marker David Barber, Member of the Royal Victorian Order feels there is no good reason not to feed the swans bread and that many are underweight as a result of the ban. Swans have been fed bread for many hundreds of years without causing any ill effects. Worryingly swans have been found wandering on roads in search of food. He went on to say that bread may not be the best dietary option for swans compared to their natural food such as river weed but it has become a very important source of energy for them. It supplements their natural diet and helps them to survive the cold winter months when vegetation is very scarce. The Queen's Swan Guard also said that there is no good reason not to feed bread to swans, provided it is not mouldy. During the winter months don't throw your left overs away "Feed the Birds".

The world fell in love with Audrey Hepburn who starred in films such as Breakfast at Tiffany's, Roman holiday and Sabrina. Her 'Hollywood Life' was very different to her early years during WWII in Holland. At 14 years old she was helping the Dutch Resistance by running around with food for American and British soldiers shot down over Holland. She was fluent in English and so was able to communicate with them. Also bravely cycling from place to place delivering the local resistance newspaper which was hidden in her woolen socks. Her beloved Uncle had been executed for refusing to support the Nazi regime (1942). Audrey helped raise money for the resistance by performing in secret local concerts. She suffered severe malnutrition due to the lack of food and

almost starved to death. In her later years she was an ambassador for UNICEF and she would travel to war-torn countries in this role. She felt that there was no greater evil than war because of its effect on the children. Audrey knew this to be true from her own young life. Although she was a movie star she never forgot her wartime experiences and tried to make this a safer world

## Scam Email Alert: TV Licence Renewal

Hertfordshire residents have been receiving convincing looking emails purporting to be from the TV Licensing authority. The emails use the official TV Licensing logo. The email informs the customer that their TV License



has recently expired and they are eligible for a free renewal. In order to receive the free TV License renewal, they need to apply by clicking on a link in the email and providing their details. This is a scam email designed to take you to a phoney website which will capture your personal details. *If you receive an email of this nature, simply delete it.* Police advice is to never click on any link sent to you in an email unless you are 100% sure that it is genuine. For more information about TV Licensing, please visit [www.tvlicensing.co.uk](http://www.tvlicensing.co.uk) (or via the gov.uk website). The TV licensing website also contains scams advice - just search on "scam" to find the advice. If you wish to enter details or log into a website of a trusted organisation, you should get to the website by typing the organisation's website name into your browser. Once at the log on screen, before you begin to enter your details and password, you should check your browser to ensure that the web address seems correct and also that it is secure (e.g. this may be indicated by a padlock). If you think you may have compromised the safety of your bank details, you should immediately contact your bank. If you wish to report a fraud or a scam, you can report online to [ActionFraud.police.uk](http://ActionFraud.police.uk) or by telephone at **0300 123 2040**. Philip Waine *Watch Liaison Officer*.

## FOULING – Byewaters is covered by a PSPO!

Unfortunately 11 years on from our first newsletter some people still have not got the message regarding fouling!! It has been brought to my attention that Byewaters has been included in the PSPO for Three Rivers Council. PSPO is a Public Spaces Protection Order and the full order can be viewed on <http://www.threerivers.gov.uk/service/public-space-protection-order-pspo>

Basically this means that owners not removing their dog's faeces on Byewaters can be fined £75 (max fine of £1000). You can report anyone seen not removing dog faeces to Three Rivers Council or contact FixMyStreet <http://www.fixmystreet.com> and they will send a report to Three Rivers. FixMyStreet does cover other matters as well such as dumped items, clearing graffiti, potholes etc. and of course dog fouling. They send your report to the people whose job it is to fix it.

There is an app for iOS and an Android app, Nokia Ovi app. If your phone isn't supported try accessing FixMyStreet via your mobile browser.

*Hopefully this can help in the fight to keep our street clean and there is no excuse as biodegradable bags are FREE from the Parish Council Offices and some libraries.*

*Always think of others and use bags to pick up after your pet and then BIN it preferably in a RED waste bin.*

## DON'T BE THE CAUSE OF AN ACCIDENT



### 20mph or less!!

Please drive slowly around the estate and park sensibly so that visibility is not obscured for either pedestrians or other vehicles. Please keep your speeds down – **20mph or less** is best. Please think of others and try not to park on pavements or on blind spots. (Parking large vehicles on or close to corners is not advisable.) If your vehicle damages a pavement you will have to be charged for the repair. Please always think of others when driving and parking around Byewaters.

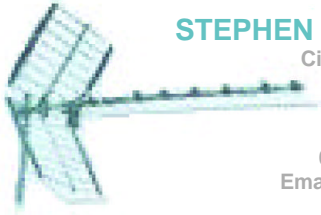

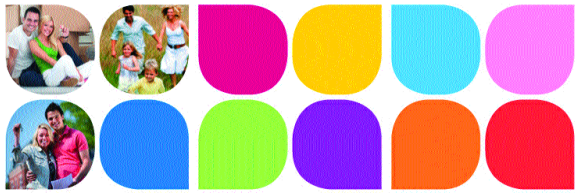
